- Application deadline for Autumn Semester (starts in the end of August) is by the end of May and for Spring Semester (starts beginning of January) is by the end of October
- When the student has been accepted, we will send an Acceptance Letter together with an information package to the address that has been provided by the student in the Application Form.
- We offer a Pick-Up service (free of charge) for the students upon their arrival to Vaasa (when possible) and a Survival Kit (including: pillow, blanket, bed linen, and curtains) for a small fee. More details can be found in the information letter upon the student's acceptance.
